Reference: Gulf Radical Cup Sporting and Technical Regulations - 2023/24, Article 4.12.4

Action: Expansion and Clarification of 4.12.4

Old Regulation:

There is a limit on the number of tyres that can be used in a race weekend. This will be 8 slick tyres per entry, either new or used. If extra tyres are required (due to puncture for eg) during the event then these must be declared to the GRC secretary of the meeting. Tyres to be used must be declared on the tyre declaration form and be handed to the competition secretary before the first qualifying session takes place. Use of tyres not declared on the designated form or late submission of this form will lead to possible disqualification. There is no limit to the amount of wet weather tyres that can be used.

New Regulation:

There is a limit on the number of tyres that can be used in a race weekend. This will be 8 slick tyres per entry, either new or used. If extra tyres are required (due to puncture or flatspot for eg) during the event then these must be declared to the GRC secretary of the meeting. Replacement tyres must be of equal or lesser condition than the damaged tyre before damage was incurred. A new tyre can be used, this will come with a 2 place grid penalty for each new tyre, If the sum of the grid penalty applied (in the case of multiple tyres damaged) is greater than the number of places to the back of the grid, you will take a back of the grid start. The penalty cannot be carried over to any other race, tyres can only be replaced at the agreement of the Chief Technical Scrutineer.

Tyres to be used must be declared on the tyre declaration form and be handed to the competition secretary before the first qualifying session takes place. Use of tyres not declared on the designated form or late submission of this form will lead to possible disqualification. There is no limit to the amount of wet weather tyres that can be used.
